

Timberline Volunteer Recognition

Each year, your TMS PTSA recognizes individuals who have given extraordinary service to our school, our organization, our community, and our students. The awards of Golden Acorn, Outstanding Educator, Outstanding Advocate, Outstanding Student Advocate, Honorary Life Membership, and Emerald Timberwolf may be given annually as determined by the PTSA Awards committee.

Emerald Timberwolf Award

This award is unique to our Timberline community and recognizes those volunteers who have demonstrated excellence in their continued service to make Timberline a better place for our students, staff, and families. This nominee should be a positive role model who has gone above and beyond for our school and who works to encourage our community to follow Timberline's PACK Way.

Golden Acorn Award

This is a nationally recognized award and is the highest award given to volunteers. This award honors those who have consistently demonstrated outstanding service to all of students at Timberline Middle School and in the Timberline community. Nominees are those who have made a commitment to helping the youth in our community and who have gone above and beyond the responsibilities of an office or job to do so. Nominees for this award are those who follow the mission of the PTSA; to promote the health, welfare, safety, and education of all children in our community. The recipient of this award will have a contribution donated in their name to the WSPTA Scholarship Program.

Outstanding Educator Award

This nationally recognized award is presented to an individual who has made significant contributions to enhance the educational outcomes of all students in our community. These nominees are not limited to teachers and may be defined as a teacher, assistant, specialist, support staff, administrator, or community member. The recipient of this award will have a contribution donated in their name to the WSPTA Scholarship Program.

Outstanding Advocate Award

This award was established in 2004 to recognize an individual for their advocacy and commitment in helping to create strong policies relating to the health, welfare, safety and education of children and youth. Recipients receive a certificate and pin, and a contribution is made in their name to the WSPTA Scholarship Program that benefits students.

Outstanding Student Advocate

This award was established in 2011 to recognize student PTA members who have made significant contributions through leadership and service in their school and community. Recipients receive a certificate and pin, and a contribution is made in their name to the WSPTA Scholarship Program that benefits students.

Honorary Timberline Middle PTSA Member Award

This award recognizes an individual who has contributed significantly to the development, growth, and sustainability of our PTSA. It is awarded to someone who has shown extraordinary commitment to the PTA's vision and mission. Recipients receive a certificate and pin, and a contribution is made in their name to the WSPTA Scholarship Program that benefits students.
